IT'S AN OFFENCE

Any member or health professional involved in fraudulent acts is guilty of an offence. To safeguard yourself and the integrity of the medical aid society, just say no! Don't take part in these activities.

STAND UNITED AGAINST FRAUD

We need your help to combat fraud. Report any health professional who offers dishonest services or engages in any form of fraud. Additionally, if you are aware of any fraudulent activity within the Society, please report it confidentially. Let's stand together and protect the interests of all members.



SAY NO TO FALSE CLAIMS

Fraudulent claims affect your benefits. Health professionals submitting false claims receive excessive compensation, which ultimately depletes your cover. Don't let your funds be drained when you genuinely require them.

CONSEQUENCES OF FRAUD

Fraud can lead to severe consequences. Taking part in fraudulent activities may result in removal from the medical aid society and even disciplinary action, including potential dismissal from your company and, in some cases, prosecution. Don't jeopardise your future. Say no to fraud.
